Beloved,

May the grace, mercy, and peace of the Lord be with you and in each one of you. We are conscious of the difficulties our country, the world, and God's people are living, and all of these affects all of us. In these situations, how true the Word of God is to us in John 16:33 that says, "I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have [perfect] peace *and* confidence. In the world you have tribulation *and* trials *and* distress *and* frustration; but be of good cheer [take courage; be confident, certain, undaunted]! For I have overcome the world". [I have deprived it of power to harm you and have conquered it for you.] These words should bring comfort and encouragement to continue to dream, to plan, and to participate in expanding God's Kingdom, evangelizing, discipling, counseling and teaching God's Word, and sharing Christ's love.



We want to share with you that from November 10 through February 8 we visited churches, friends, and families in both the USA and Curaçao to share our ministry and to be with them. It has been a good time of encouragement, of strength and to renew our vision to continue to be faithful to the call to be servants of the Most High God. During that time, I visited a supporting church in the island of Aruba from January 27-30, but when I took a test to fly back to Curaçao, I tested positive with COVID-19! I was by myself, as Eva stayed in Curaçao. We had promised each other to be together in case of COVID, but God had other plans - He wanted me to go through this with Him,

with Eva at distance. I stayed with a wonderful family in Aruba, Nelson and Lilian Kelly, who took good care of me during those days. I praise God for His school of teaching me His personal care. I praise God for Eva, for her love, care, and encouragement from distance. I believe that this was a great part of the medicine I needed in my recovery.

We arrived at Lima on February 8 and it took us some time to settle back in into the routine of ministry. We love our church, La Roca, and it is our prayer that this church will continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ through men and women that love the Lord and are faithful and committed to the call that the Lord has placed in each one of them.

The Prenatal Center, even in the midst of COVID and all the restrictions and protocols, continues to give Biblical counseling, medical care, and sharing the love of Jesus Christ to so many teenagers and women in need of love.



The ministry of La Roca church also has experienced a significant growth in the children's ministry. A family member of the church opened their house to host a Bible Club, to preach the gospel and to teach God's

Word. Every Friday night around 30 kids come to this house to receive Biblical counseling and instructions. We exalt our Lord for His marvelous

plans, for our youth ministries that are meeting back in person and their leaders, and also for the growth in the church. I had the blessing to baptize 24 new believers in one service, and the next week another 5 believers were baptized as well! It is our prayer

to continue to win souls for the glory and praise of our Lord Jesus Christ.

La Roca Christian School will start classes in person March 14 after 2 years of giving virtual academic instruction. Praise the Lord!!! Since March 1 all the teacher staff has been coming in to the school to clean, to prepare their classes to receive their children, to pray together and to have devotions together every morning. What a blessing for me, by the grace of God, to have a small part in the lives of our teachers. This year we will start with 350 students. This year we decided to be more intentional in preaching the gospel to every student, and we want to invite you to be part of this, praying for this ministry of the gospel. The school staff that will be

working this year at La Roca is of 45 including those that work in maintenance and at the door. Please, I want to ask you to pray for each one of them that everyone will be committed to show the love



and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ through their words and actions. In times like these, God is calling us to the extraordinary.

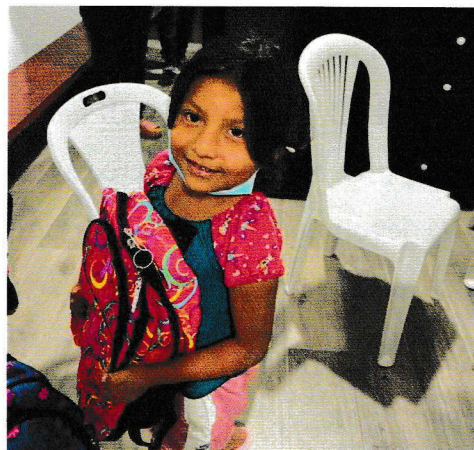

La Roca Christian Church in Roldan, a new church God established during the pandemic, is also growing. We have 5 families from La Roca

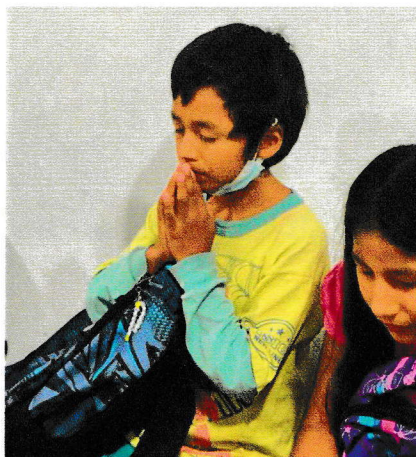


